Call for Nominations – NASPS Governing Board

Term: January 1st 2019 – December 31st 2020

The North American Sturgeon and Paddlefish Society (NASPS) will be holding elections this summer for positions on their governing board. NASPS is seeking nominations for 10 positions including President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and six members at large. If you would like to nominate someone for any of these positions please submit their name along with their contact information to James Crossman (james.crossman@bchydro.com) and Andrea Schreier (andrauch@ucdavis.edu) by June 29th. Nominees will be required to submit a short biography (<150 words) by July 20th. Nominees must be a NASPS member in good standing to be included on the ballot. Candidate biographies will be distributed to NASPS members and will also be made available through the NASPS website (www.nasps-sturgeon.org). Voting will occur for a period of 30 days in August and will be conducted online with an option to submit your votes through email if needed. To vote, you must be a NASPS member in good standing.
